Ballooning

The Mongolfier brothers, Joseph and Elienne, were French papermakers who began (0) with hot air balloons in the late 1700s. They started by (1) small paper bags with smoke. At first, they thought the smoke (2) the bags ascend, but they later learned that it was the hot air which caused the bags to (3)

In June 1783, the brothers sent up a balloon made of cloth lined with paper, which (4) 12 metres in diameter.
