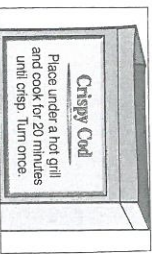

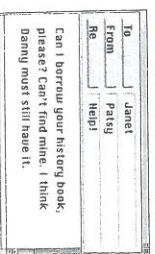

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS



Performing Arts

We can't guarantee you will be picking up an award at the next international film festival or that you will get the leading role in the next box-office hit, but we can guarantee that you will get the best possible training in the performing arts. The course is 3 years long and is designed to improve your acting skills. Main subjects are Voice, Movement and Script Analysis. In addition, you will also be able to choose 2 subjects from the following: stage lighting, costume design, scenery design, theatrical production and technical writing. During the course, you will develop qualities which will be useful to you in your career, such as communication and negotiating skills and the ability to meet deadlines under pressure. This course has no formal entry requirements. Students must attend an audition. All students who pass the audition will be interviewed before they are offered a place on the course.



Psychology: Phobia Counselling

This year the Psychology Department will be offering a new course called 'Phobia Counselling'. We have introduced this course because of the increasing number of people consulting their family doctors about phobias. In the past, people have kept their phobias to themselves, but as a result of the recent 'Fight That Phobia' campaign, more and more people are admitting their fears. The course is divided into 2 parts. Part 1 is the study of phobias, where we look at the theories of how these irrational fears develop and learn about all the different types of phobias. Part 2 is psychology-based and concentrates on ways of helping people to overcome their phobias using various methods, including new relaxation techniques and behavioural therapy.
