What if I hated it and was even lonelier? I couldn't just get off in mid-ocean! But HAS was very positive about it and they were right! It was very easy to meet and talk to people. During the voyage I socialised a lot, and found a new circle of friend We've all promised to keep in touch. I feel as if I've been given a whole new lease of life."
